Dear 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Students and Families,

If you selected the In-Person program this first marking period, welcome back to the building! We know that you have been working hard virtually and are now excited to have you return to the building on Tuesday, September 29<sup>th</sup>. Some changes have been made from the last time you were in the building to help ensure the health and safety of students and staff. Please read each item below carefully.

- The COVID-19 Screening Form must be filled out through the Genesis Parent Portal every day by 7:30 am. It is very important that this form is completed before your child comes to school.

- Students who take the bus will be picked up at the location listed on the bus pass found under the Bus tab in Genesis. Your bus pass is only valid at the stop listed. Students not in family groups will be seated using socially distant guidelines and all must wear their masks while on the bus.
- All students and staff members must wear a mask at all times in the building. There will be times when students are outside for recess and 'mask breaks' where students may take them off.
- Students should not be dropped off to school before 8:45 am. The doors will open and students will be permitted to enter the building at 8:50 am.
- Students who are dropped off from the car line will enter the building at door 4 while students who walk or arrive via the bus will enter the building at door 1 (main entrance). So you are aware, Kindergarten enters at door 29 while 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> graders enter door 32.
- Once students enter the building Tuesday morning they should report to the following locations to meet their Homeroom and Enrichment teachers:
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> grade – Large Cafeteria
  - 4<sup>th</sup> grade – Gym
  - 5<sup>th</sup> grade – Auditorium
- At dismissal, students who are walkers or picked-up by a parent or guardian will be dismissed at door 6 which faces the playground next to the parking lot. Please bring identification so your child can be released to you. By Friday, we hope to have family cards available to you which will assist with a quick dismissal. Bus riders will be escorted to their busses and attendance will be taken before the bus is permitted to depart.
- Breakfast and lunch purchases are now cashless and parents are asked to pre-order lunch in advance. Please visit the Food Service link under the District Information tab on the district website. We will take daily lunch counts during the morning meeting the first few weeks as parents get more accustomed to the procedure.
