Dear Parents,

We are excited to welcome your children to the district's In-Person learning Program!

Our teachers are providing a technology infused, blended learning –approach to instruction. During the school day, teachers are providing students an in-class experience to login to Google Classroom on their iPad. The goal is to prepare students to use their iPad to participate in a virtual learning day.

Starting Tuesday, October 27th, all grade K-1 students will bring home their iPads Monday through Thursday evenings. The iPads will remain in school on Friday for charging over the weekend and to provide students an opportunity to have a screen break and participate in non-computer based activities such as reading a book, playing math games or just being outside. **Your child must bring their district provided iPad and charger to school daily.**

Your child's teacher will set a date and time the week of October 27th to practice signing into Google Classroom at home. Please check the Google Classroom message for this information.

All students have participated in the iReady assessment for reading and math. After completing the assessment, a personalized *learning pathway* was designed for each student. This pathway provides supplemental instruction and strengthens identified skills areas. Your child's teacher will provide you a unique login to access the iReady instruction. Once the student has demonstrated progress in the skills, new individualizes pathways will be created. We ask each family to schedule two (2), 15 minute iReady reading times and two (2) 15 minute iReady math times weekly, Monday through Thursday to support your child's learning. For example, Monday and Tuesday could be iReady reading pathway days and Wednesday and Thursday are iReady math pathway days. Your child's teacher will monitor student progress, adjust the learning pathways and follow up individually with students as needed.

There have been several questions regarding the process a parent/guardian should take in the event that a district-issued iPad or Chromebook is damaged. To clarify, **School** will repair or replace damaged equipment due to normal usage. Repair costs associated with breakage and damages deemed as willful abuse, theft or neglect will be the responsibility of the student/parent/guardian and could be subject to the full device cost.

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You have the option to purchase device insurance to cover the cost of repair/replacement in the event of damage related to device neglect or abuse. **The cost to purchase the insurance is \$15.** One2One Risk Solutions is the leader in education risk management, serving over 3,500 public school districts throughout the country.
