

Ewing Township Public Schools Summer Reading 2023 Students Entering Grades 1 and 2

Dear Kindergarten and First Grade Students and Parents/Guardians:

Reading to your child or with your child at home helps to make him or her a better listener, improves vocabulary development, and can improve his/her overall academic success. A parent/guardian who reads to or with his/her child for twenty minutes each day will provide an additional 3,600 minutes of reading each year (1,800,000 words per year).

Over the summer, we encourage families to read together or find a way to make it an enjoyable experience, not a chore.

To promote reading at home, this year's summer reading for students entering grades 1 and 2 will give students the opportunity to read independently, read with a partner, or listen to a book being read to them.

Summer Reading 2023

- The books chosen by students entering grades 1 and 2 can be read independently or can be read with someone else. The goal is to read...read...read, so reading together counts! You can even read books in another language!
- The book can be one you have at home (but haven't ever read before), an eBook or audiobook from MackinVIA, one that you purchase, or one borrowed from the Mercer County Library System.
- Websites such as Storyline Online (www.storylineonline.net) and Raz-Kids "count" as reading.
- The media specialists have included some recommended reading resources and a recommended reading list to help you and your children.

Summer Reading Log

- Help your child record the pages read each time they read. Use the attached Summer Reading Log and mark whether each book was read independently, with a partner, or read by an adult.
- The Reading Log must be given to your teacher by Friday, September 8, 2023
- Any student who returns a log will be entered in a raffle!
