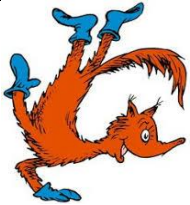




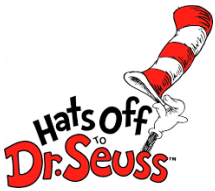
Attention Lore School!

Extra fun: Write a silly story about the craziest socks you've ever seen. Read your story to your family.



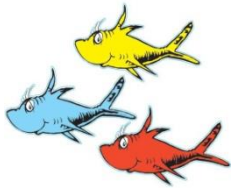
Tuesday, March 2nd: Dr. Seuss' Birthday/The Cat in the Hat Day
