Welcome to Kindergarten! My name is Mrs. Mack, and I will be your child's kindergarten teacher. I hope your summer is going well and that you've had some time to play and relax. My family and I live in Ewing, so we've been spending time around the area. I hope by the time school begins we'll all have stories to share about our summer adventures.

The **first day of school** is **Tuesday, September 6**. Kindergarten is a fun and eventful year. I want your child to be ready for the first day, so here is a list of supplies he/she will need.

Lunch: For the first few days of school we encourage parents to send lunch rather than have a child buy it. Please **write your child's name on his/her lunch bag** and make sure your child knows that this is his/her lunch

Snack: Please send a small, healthy snack daily. **Write your child's name on his/her snack**, label it "Snack", and place it in a separate bag from lunch.

Book Bag: Please label and be sure it is large enough to safely carry a folder, projects, and extra pair of clothes.

Sneakers: Should be worn daily for playground safety.

**Sweater/
Sweatshirt:** Our classrooms can be cold while the air conditioning is still on.

Water bottle: Please label. We will use it daily for class water breaks.

**Extra change of
Cloths:** Please pack an extra change of clothes that will stay in your child's book bag.

The following is a list of items that your child will use throughout the school year. These items need to be labeled with your child's name on the first day of school. *If you need assistance with supplies, please contact Lore School's main office.*





- 1 – Pocket folder of your choice (laminated folders are more durable)
- 1 – Hard plastic pencil case or large pencil pouch
- 4 – 24 Box of Crayons
- 6 – Jumbo glue sticks
- 4 – Containers of Play Doh
- 1 – 4-6 Pack of black dry erase markers
- 1 – Standard plug in headphones (no Bluetooth or microphone please)

Below are “**wish list**” items that are used as communal supplies if you are able to donate them:

- Gallon and quart sized zip lock bags
- Standard thick markers
- Clorox wipes
- Baby wipes
- Tissues
