<p>Please DO: Keep your children in your car until the bell rings at 8:50 am.</p>	<p>Please DON'T: Allow your child to leave your car until the bell rings at 8:50 am.</p>
<p>Please DO: Wait in the car line on Westwood Drive.</p>	<p>Please DON'T: Block the driveways of houses on Westwood Drive.</p>
<p>Please DO: Have your child ready to exit the car with their backpack, coat on, and anything else they need for the day.</p>	<p>Please DON'T: Leave your car. Staff is on hand to help children, if needed.</p>
<p>Please DO: Pull completely down to the STOP SIGN (or as close as possible) by Principal Kawalek.</p>	<p>Please DON'T: Stop until you can pull completely down the lane, as much as possible.</p>
<p>Please DO: Have your child unload your car from the PASSENGER SIDE ONLY (Sidewalk side).</p>	<p>Please DON'T: Have your child exit on the street side. Children should never walk between cars.</p>
<p>Please DO: Wait in line until the car line moves.</p>	<p>Please DON'T: Use your cell phone while in the car line.</p>
<p>Please DO: Look for Mr. Knott to safely exit the driveway. He manages the intersection of cars and buses.</p>	<p>Please DON'T: Forget to look for Mr. Knott's sign to tell you when to move.</p>
<p>Please DO: Use the car line to drop your child off. True Walkers may be dropped off by the Crossing Guard.</p>	<p>Please DON'T: Walk your child up to school.</p>

<p>Please DO: Contact the office BEFORE 3:00 PM with any changes to your child's dismissal plan. Please send a note or call Ext. 6100.</p>	<p>Please DON'T: Pick up your child after 3:00 without having sent a note.</p>
<p>Please DO: Wait in the car line on Westwood Drive.</p>	<p>Please DON'T: Skip the car line. Kids are dismissed in the order of the car line.</p>
<p>Please DO: Place the GREEN SIGN with your family name visible in your car windshield.</p>	<p>Please DON'T: Block the driveways of houses on Westwood Drive.</p>
<p>Please DO: Pull completely down to the STOP SIGN (or as close as possible) by Principal Kawalek.</p>	<p>Please DON'T: Get out of your car to greet your child, unless they need help with their seatbelt.</p>
<p>Please DO: Have your child load your car from the PASSENGER SIDE ONLY (sidewalk side).</p>	<p>Please DON'T: Allow your child to enter on the driver's side of the car (street side). Children should not walk between cars.</p>
<p>Please DO: Wait in line until the car line moves.</p>	<p>Please DON'T: Exit the car line early. This can cause an accident.</p>
<p>Please DO: Actively watch for children moving near your car.</p>	<p>Please DON'T: Use your cell phone while in the car line.</p>
<p>Please DO: Look for Mr. Knott to safely exit the driveway. He manages the intersection of cars and buses.</p>	<p>Please DON'T: Forget to look for Mr. Knott's sign to tell you when to move.</p>
<p>** TRUE WALKERS ONLY** Please DO: Park by the Crossing Guard. Your child will walk to you.</p>	<p>** TRUE WALKERS ONLY** Please DON'T: Walk up to school to greet your child.</p>
