The Ewing Public Schools BOE Board Briefs: November 28, 2016

The November 28th Board of Education meeting was held at Lore Elementary School, part of the BOE's 'traveling Board meeting' approach, which enables the Board to visit each district school, tour the building, meet staff and receive an update from the building principal.

Lore was the first stop on the Board's tour, with future school visitations for 2017 being set at the Board's January Reorganization on January 9th.

EHS student representative to the BOE, Senior Caroline Unger, gave an update to the Board and public about happenings at Ewing High School, including Spirit Week and the school's College Application Preparation program.

In his update to the Board of Education, Lore Principal Ed Chmiel provided an overview of the first several months of school at Lore, touching on school community functions, service projects, and other events in the award-winning school.

Assistant Superintendent Dr. Ishibashi, joined by several of her curriculum team staff members, then presented the required NCLB assessment update. Her presentation will be made available on the district website under the Parent Information/PARCC Information tab.

During the Agenda session of the meeting, the Board approved items pertaining to certifying the official BOE Election results, new curricular additions to the Life Skills/Transitions program at the high school, and the annual review of the Nursing Services Plan.

The following policy was approved by the Board as a "First Readings". After review and approval by the Board at its next meeting in December, it will become formal Board policy:
