The Ewing Public Schools BOE Board Briefs: October 30th, 2017

The Ewing Township Board of Education held its monthly meeting in the Fisher Middle School media center on Monday, October 30th, 2017.

Ewing High School student ambassadors to the Board of Education, Keri Capstack and Serina Montero, updated the Board and public on events and developments at EHS during the month October, including Spirit Week, Homecoming and the Football and Girls Soccer programs advancing into the state playoffs.

During his Superintendent's Report, Chief School Administrator Michael Nitti reflected upon the "Week of Respect" that took place in all the district schools, and shared some of the activities that were implemented that are designed to promote a positive, safe and harmonious learning environment.
