The Ewing Township Board of Education held its monthly meeting in the Fisher Middle School media center on Monday, July 31<sup>st</sup>, 2017.

During the **Superintendent's Report**, Chief School Administrator Michael Nitti updated the Board about the district's summer programs, including the Extended School Year program, Summer Achievement Academy, and Ready Freddy program.
