#### The Ewing Public Schools Board of Education Board Briefs: February 25th, 2019

The Ewing Township Board of Education held its monthly meeting in the Antheil Elementary School auditorium on Monday, February 25<sup>h</sup>, 2019.

This was the third of the Board's traveling meetings for the 2018-19 school year, as the Board visited Lore School in November, Parkway School in January and now Antheil School in February. These meetings give the Board the opportunity to tour the schools, meet with staff, and receive an update from the school leadership.

Ewing High School student ambassador to the Board of Education, Nadlie Alexis, updated the Board and public on events and developments at EHS during the month of February. The ambassador touched on the success of the winter sports programs, high school endeavors to celebrate Black History Month, and the excitement over the debut of the musical "Legally Blonde, The Musical" next week.

During the "**Superintendent's Report**," Superintendent Nitti then introduced Antheil Principal Jennifer Whitner, for a presentation on the Antheil School. Principal Whitner was joined by her student "Principal of the Day," 5<sup>th</sup> Grader, Isabella DeStefano, who provided an update on events, activities, happenings and accomplishments at Antheil Elementary School.

Superintendent Nitti was then joined by School Business Administrator Dennis Nettleton, as they provided an update on the preliminary budget process, as the district awaits its revenue numbers after the governor's budget address in mid-March. The preliminary budget will be finalized and presented to the Board for approval at the March 18<sup>th</sup> Board of Education meeting.

The Board then moved into the "Superintendent Recommendation" section of the Agenda. Some items of note:

#### Finance and Operations

The Board accepted the Annual Audit dated June 30, 2018. The audit was completed by Mr. Daniel DiGangi, CPA, RMA, PSA of the accounting firm Bowman & Company, LLP. School Business Administrator Mr. Nettleton expressed his gratitude to the staff of the business office for all their help and assistance with the audit.
