Available Programs

Birding in Your Backyard – Identify the many beautiful birds right in their backyards, and begin learning to use binoculars and field guides.

Incredible Insects – Go on an insect safari to learn how honey bees, ants and other insects benefit the environment.

Turtle Day – Focus on our four-legged reptile friends with an eye towards thermoregulation and what it takes to be a turtle.

Adventures in Hiking – Explore the outdoors by hiking the marsh, complete with team building exercises and scavenger hunt on the trails. Bring your water bottle and an extra snack.

Stream Shenanigans – Learn about the “little critters” and macroinvertebrates that live in our streams and swamps.

Orienteering – Using a compass, campers work as a team to navigate an orienteering course.
