To Our 2020 Resident Scarecrow Hosts:

Thank you for agreeing to create and host a scarecrow in our 2nd annual **All-Around Town Scarecrow Scavenger Hunt**. We held our inaugural 'Hunt' in 2019 and were delighted with the excitement it generated and community participation. Thirty-four scarecrows were situated throughout Ewing and almost one hundred groups and families enjoyed hunting them down. This year we recognize that our world as we knew it is in a very different and scary place. Whether socially, financially and/or personally; everyone is affected. This year more than ever, businesses, residents, and organizations need to have a positive experience to enjoy. 2020 has been a challenging year and we're hoping that 'Scary Invaders' appearing once again throughout Ewing Township will be a boost to businesses and the community alike.

## 2020 HUNT DETAILS

**PARTICIPATION** in the Scavenger Hunt is free and open to all in Ewing. Create your Scarecrow and display it securely, hiding behind a bush, leaning against a lamp post, or wherever your imagination dictates. Scarecrows can be spooky, patriotic, green, whatever you want, all creative imaginations welcome. **REGISTRATION:** Fill out and submit the official Registration Form by **September 10<sup>th</sup> at the latest**. The online form is available at <https://ewinggreenteam.org/scarecrow-savenger-hunt-reg/>.

**SCARECROW 'HUNT' DATES:** Thursday, October 1<sup>st</sup> – through Thursday, October 29<sup>th</sup>. Your Scarecrow must be ready and on display by **the morning of October 1<sup>st</sup> through October 29<sup>th</sup>**.

**SCARECROW NAME & NUMBER:** Name your scarecrow. You will also be assigned a number which will correspond to your scarecrow's place on the ballot. Both the name and number must be on your scarecrow's sign. They must be securely affixed, prominently displayed, and easy to read for the 'hunters.'

**PRIZES:** There are People's Choice prizes (voted upon by the hunters), and a raffle prize pulled from all entries (number of entries for each hunter dependent upon the number of scarecrows found.) And, new this year, those who create scarecrows may compete for a **Green Team prize**, a monetary award that will be given to the scarecrow which represents the best use of recycled/upcycled materials (80%). Winners will be announced on October 31<sup>st</sup>. Dollar amounts for prizes are still being determined but range from \$100 - \$200.

**SCARECROW LOCATION:** Please display your Scarecrow in your front yard (securely and able to withstand the elements), to make it possible for people to keep their distance. Questions about where to place your scarecrow? Contact Lisa Feldman at 609-620-0722. Residents setting up a scarecrow elsewhere instead of their homes (following Green Team approval) please mark 'resident' on your sign.
