Anglers

Ages: 10–12 years by Oct. 1, 2024. \$250/week Mercer County residents \$350/week Out-of-county residents

Campers will practice the specific skills necessary for all avid anglers, including choosing the appropriate bait, species identification, and finding habitats along Mercer Lake where they will have the most success. Size limits and fish biology will be covered while practicing catch and release fishing.

Kayakers

Ages: 13-15 years by Oct. 1, 2024. \$300/week Mercer County Residents \$400/week Out-of-county residents

Campers will paddle a kayak each morning on a quest to discover and investigate the shoreline, creeks, and hidden coves of Lake Mercer. Campers will explore the lake's ecology by learning to identify the diverse plant and wildlife, both on land and in water, and then end each day with fun and games. For their safety, campers attending Kayak camp need to know how to swim.


