What:



Enrichment Instructor

Enrichment Instructors conduct classes, workshops, demonstrations and provides instruction to students on topics and skills such as cooking, STEM, art and physical education.

Starting rate: \$18 per/hr

Bus Attendant

Bus Attendants maintain order and discipline on the bus to ensure the safety of each club member. They assist the driver with monitoring and inspection of the bus. They provide support and instruction to the club members to ensure their understanding and compliance with bus safety rules.

Starting rate: \$16 per/hr

Site Coordinator

The Site Coordinator is responsible for overseeing the daily coordination of the program. This includes maintaining school-based relationships with administrators and teachers, monitoring program flow and structure. Managing day-to-day operations of the after-school program, training and supervising staff and organizing schedules of academic.

Rate: \$22 per/hr

Flex Staff

Flex Staff provide supervision duties inside and outside the club house to ensure a safe environment for club members during program. Flex Staff prepare classrooms for activities and assist with arrival and dismissal of club members. They provide extra support by supervising students during field trips and activities.

Starting rate: \$16 per/hr

Literacy/SEL Specialist

Literacy and Social Emotional Learning Specialists are responsible for identifying and working with youth on strengthening social emotional and literacy skills.


