We will be able to offer ten tickets per student. Seating will be general admission and there will be no reserved seating. We plan on livestreaming the ceremony. The CURE Arena will open its doors for seating at 6 p.m., one hour before the ceremony begins. Only guests with graduation tickets will be admitted to the ceremony. Please be aware of the following requirements and event details:

1. All graduates must complete the 2024 Senior Class Exit Survey by Friday, June 14th. The exit survey can be accessed by all seniors through Naviance.
2. There is a mandatory graduation meeting for seniors on Tuesday, June 11th at 2:45 p.m. in the EHS auditorium and a practice on Thursday, June 13th at 10 a.m. at the CURE Insurance Arena. Students who will need transportation to the arena practice should sign up for busing in the 2024 Google Classroom.
3. Caps, gowns, and tickets will be distributed to those who have completed their exit survey and have met the academic requirements for graduation beginning on Monday, June 17th.
4. Seniors should arrive by 5:45 p.m. on June 21st for procession line up. Graduates should park in Lot 2 and enter at the bottom of the ramp behind the Arena.
5. Graduates who do not wish to participate in the ceremony may pick up their diplomas in the Main Office beginning on Tuesday, June 25th.
