**FMS Recreational Sports and Fitness Program**-will combine fitness activities, recreational games and soccer (Advisors Mrs. Johnson [ljohnson@ewingboe.org](mailto:ljohnson@ewingboe.org) and Mr. Jones [pjones@ewingboe.org](mailto:pjones@ewingboe.org))

Please remember that students will have to be dropped off at 3:15 p.m. at their designated activity area prepared to participate and picked up in the same area at the conclusion of the activity. Parents should not get out of their cars or stay for the duration of the activity due to health concerns. All COVID 19 protocols and social distancing requirements will be followed, as well as a daily screening for students upon arrival.

We would like to begin these offerings on Monday, April 19<sup>th</sup>. In order for that to occur, it is essential that all required paperwork is filled out quickly and efficiently.

**Athletic permission forms and Intramural forms can be found in the Genesis Parent portal.**

If a student wishes to participate in FMS Baseball/Softball or the Recreation Program, the parent/guardian should complete the mandated paperwork and documentation online. Parent/Guardians should simply go to the Genesis Parent Portal and click on the "Forms" link - scroll to the Athletics Forms and fill out all of the required information.

For FMS Baseball or Softball a new physical is required if the previous physical exam was longer than 365 days prior - those forms must be submitted on paper because the law requires the physical forms to be signed and stamped by a physician. No physical examination is needed to participate in the Recreation Program.

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Mr. Covington is currently working on a schedule for FMS Baseball and Softball and will release information as it evolves.

**Student would be responsible for the following daily:**

- All students would have to answer daily check in questions after temperature has been taken upon arrival.
- All students would be required to get their temperature checked upon arrival. Any student who has a temperature higher than 99.9 will be sent home.
- \*Parents are required to wait until the student has passed the daily screening checks before leaving, in the event your athlete needs to be sent home.
- All students will be required to bring their own water bottles or they will be sent home.
- All students are required to be promptly picked up after practices to avoid breaking social distancing guidelines.
- All students are responsible for sanitation of personal equipment.
